Objective: Fun Summer Activity. Fine motor development (cutting, tying)


Make a Hula Skirt

Supplies:

- 48" X 24 ft rolls of assorted Smart-Fab colors
- Yarn or Rope cut at least 6 inches wider than students waists so that it can be tied
- 9x12 pack of assorted Smart-Fab colors for fake flowers or Hawaiian Symbols
- Scissors
- · Rotary cutter and mat
- Scotch permanent adhesive dots

Steps to Make a Hula Skirt

1 Students are measured and rope is cut at least 6 inches on each end wider than student's waist.



Steps to Make a Hula Skirt

- Students are given a piece of Smart-Fab that has been pre-cut with the rotary cutter.
- **3** Fold the 48" side in held and in half again to make it easier to cut.







4 Students cut Smart-fab into 3-4 inch wide strips.



5 Strips are tied around rope at the halfway point.



6 Repeat Steps 2 & 3 to desired fullness of skirt.



Hawaiian symbols and fake flowers are tied around rope to decorate.
