Make a Spring Collage



Steps to Make a Spring Collage

DAY 1

1

Choose a 12x18 sheet of Smart-Fab for background



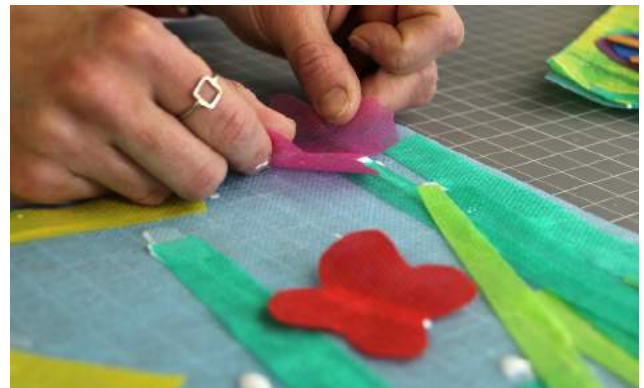
2

Cut 9x12 Smart-Fab into green strips for stems and glue to background.



Supplies:

- 12x18 Smart-Fab for background
- 9x12 Smart-Fab in assorted colors for collage
- Circle tracers in various sizes
- Scissors
- Glue
- Mod-Podge[®]
- Brad fasteners
- Colored markers
- Place mat

Cut and glue other spring details (sun, bugs, birds, etc.), leaving off the flowers.


Steps to Make a Spring Collage

- 4 Put collage on place mat and cover in mod podge (will soak through).
- 5 Place on drying rack.



DAY 2



- 6 Trace and cut out various sized circles from bright colors.
-  **OPTIONAL** Cut edges to resemble flower petals.
- 7 Stack circles, biggest to smallest, and pierce with a brad fastener.



- 8 Use brad fastener to attach flowers to stems.



- 9 Use markers to add patterns/details.
