Make a Valentine's Day Story Card



Steps to Make a Valentine's Story Card

DAY 1



Fold cardstock in half to make a card.







Pold front half of card in half LIGHTLY and cut out half of a heart then open to reveal other half.

Supplies:

- 9x12 Smart-Fab in assorted colors
- One 12x18 white or black cardstock and one 9x12 cardstock (for backing)
- Scissors
- Glue
- Black permanent marker



- Stack desired colors of Smart-Fab and cut strips in desired width.
- **OPTIONAL** Write on each strip (poem, words, sentences, names).

Steps to Make a Valentine's Story Card

Open card and draw a ring of glue around heart.





- Place strips across heart opening, overlapping each a small amount.

 * If words are on the strips, place the strips with the words facing out of the heart.
- Repeat until heart is covered.

- 7 Draw another ring of glue around heart and around edge of that half of the card.
- 8 Place cardstock as a backing, avoiding the fold.
- Place on drying rack to dry.



DAY 2

- 10 Fold card.
- Write a personalized message, story, or poem inside.
